

## BTEC FEES SCHEDULE 2009 - 2010

The Brookhouse Academy of Performing Arts (or B/hAPA) is an approved centre for offering internationally accredited Business and Technology (or BTEC) Music Diploma courses through the Edexcel Examinations Board, UK.

The following outlines the fees charged for the academic year, 2009 -2010:

**These fees are payable at the commencement of each term in Kenyan Shillings or US Dollars.**

The academic year for Brookhouse International School is split into three terms and runs September – July.

Term One (September – December)      Term Two (January – March)      Term Three (April – July)

*BTEC students can commence their course at the beginning of Term One (September) or Term Two (January).*

*Parents are at liberty to choose in which currency they wish to pay school fees. Payment for the year should remain within the nominated currency. Payments must be made by either telegraphic transfer or by local bankers cheque.*

The tuition cost includes all textbooks and some stationery. The student is expected to provide some items of equipment as listed in the handbook for parents and students.
